Grade 5 performance writing by gender

A roughly equal number of grade five girls and boys in Federated States of Micronesia had their performance analysed in the PILNA 2021 writing assessment: 49% grade five girls and 51% grade five boys.




Mean performance of grade 5 students in writing by gender, FSM, PILNA 2021

Figure CWF5.3 shows the average writing performance of grade five students in Federated States of Micronesia by gender. On average, grade five girls scored higher (480.07, SD = 69.23) than grade five boys (466.34, SD = 66.86). Grade five girls also



scored higher, on average, than grade five boys in writing performance in 2015 and 2018, Figure CWF5.4.
