Continuity of learning measures

Along with the school closure information, school leaders were asked to indicate what measures were in place to provide continuity of learning during school closures. The measures that were asked about focused on the provision and availability of learning materials and communication with students and parents. Table SLT3.3 shows the percentage of students in Fiji in PILNA 2021 who attended schools with specific continuity of learning measures being implemented, available but not implemented, and not available.
