

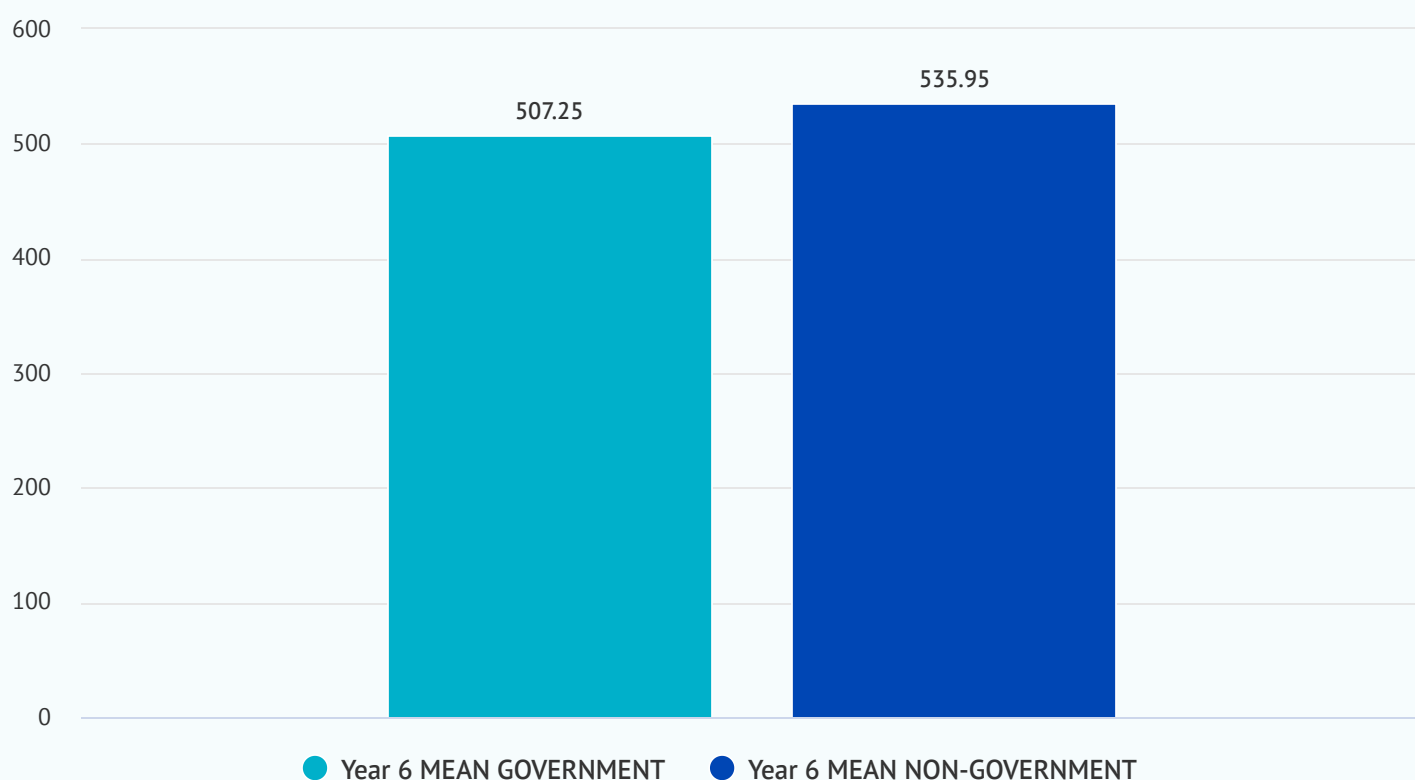

Year 6 reading performance by school authority

Most year six students who had their performance analysed in the PILNA 2021 reading assessment were enrolled in government schools: 76% in government schools and 24% in non-government schools.

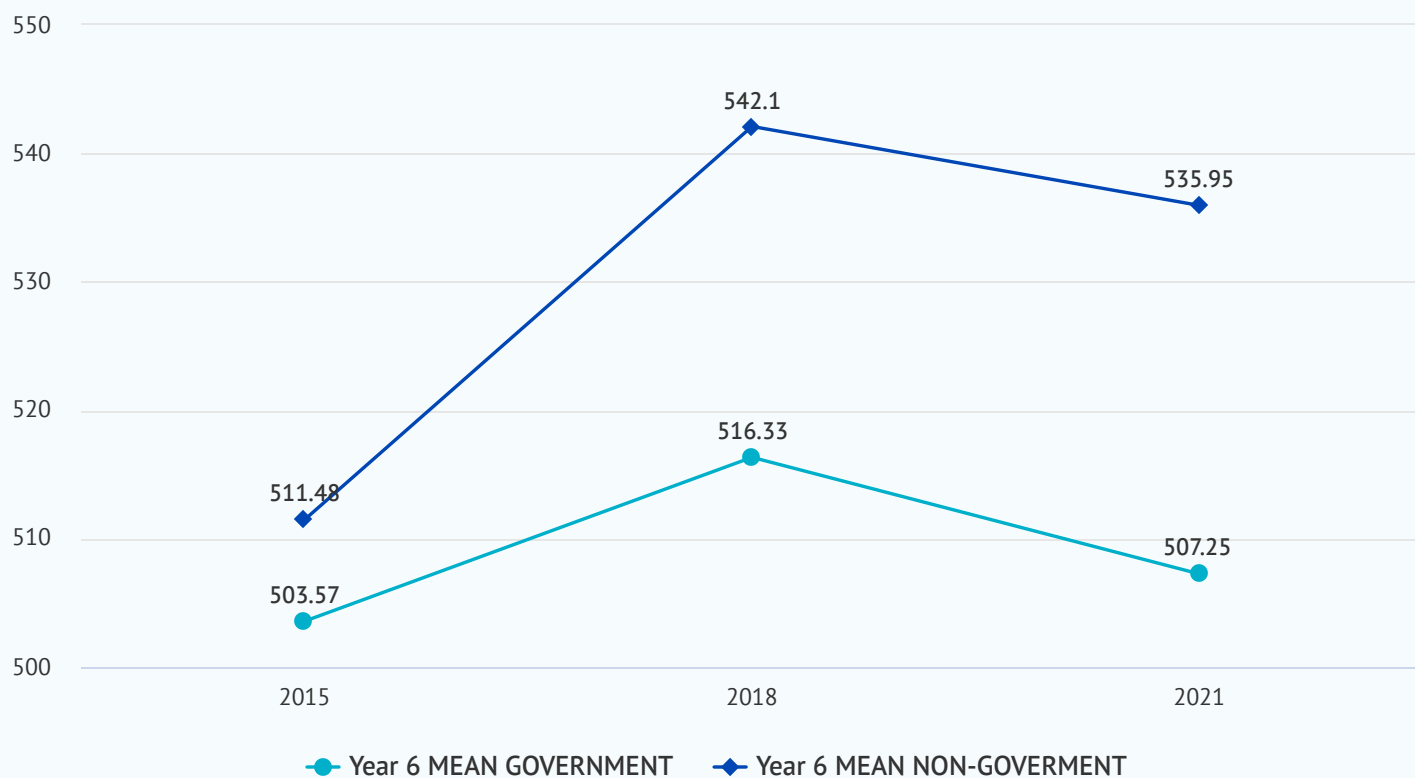
Mean performance of Year 6 students in reading by school authority, Solomon Islands, PILNA 2021

Figure CRF6.5 shows the average performance of year six students by school authority. Students in government schools showed higher reading performance than those in non-government schools. This is consistent with the two previous PILNA

cycles, 2015 and 2018 (Figure CRF6.6).
