

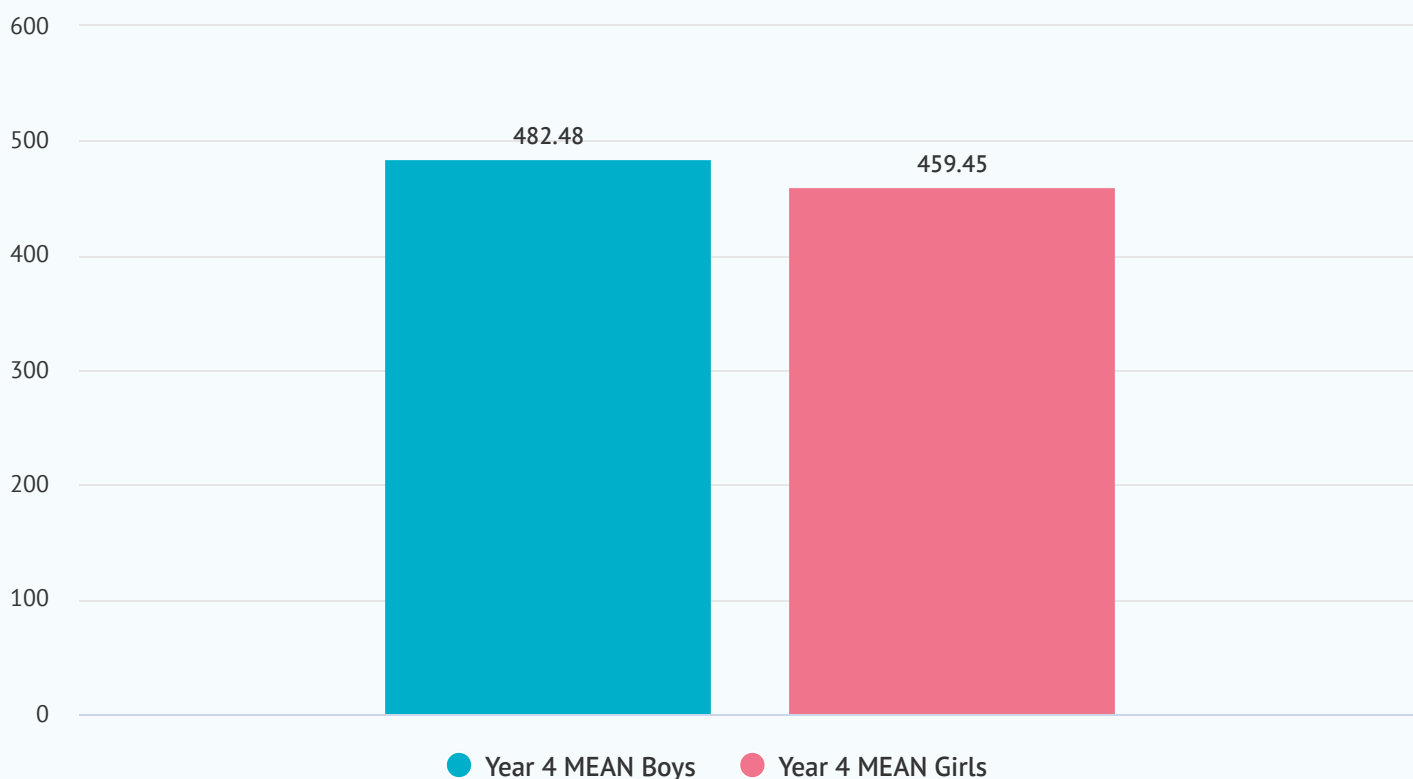

A roughly equal number of year four girls and boys in Tuvalu had their performance analysed in the PILNA 2021 writing assessment: 47% girls and 53% boys.

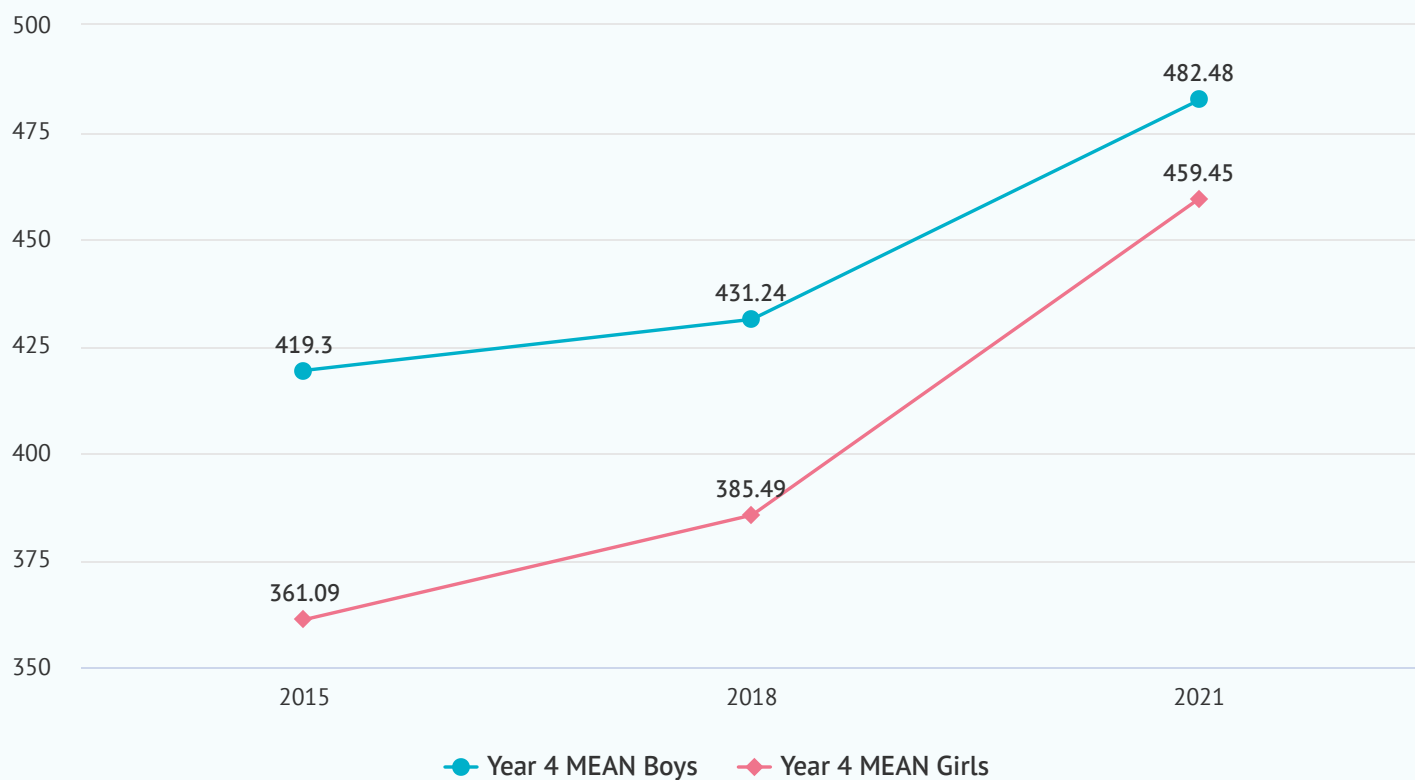
Mean performance of Year 4 students by gender, 2021

Figure CWF4.4 shows the average writing performance of year four students in Tuvalu by gender. On average, year four girls (482.48) scored higher than year four boys (459.45). They also scored higher, on average, than year four boys in writing

performance in 2015 and 2018.
